

LMA Shuttles: Your Direc(T) Connection

The LMA shuttles are one of the most highly utilized services that Longwood Collective provides in the district in collaboration with our member institutions, offering the students and staff of these organizations free last mile connections between the LMA and seven MBTA subway and commuter rail stations, major local bus hubs, off-site parking locations, and residential neighborhoods.

Popular boarding areas that the LMA Shuttles serve:

ORANGE LINE

Ruggles

COMMUTER RAIL

Lansdowne (Worcester/Framingham line), Ruggles (Franklin, Needham, Providence/Stoughton lines), JFK Station (Greenbush Line, Kingston Line, Middleborough/Lakeville Line)

PARKING AREAS

Renaissance Park Garage, Fenway Garage, Ipswich Street Garage, 55 Jersey Street and Lansdowne Station lot, MFA garage, and more




WHO can ride: Open to employees and students with an eligible ID from one of the 22 Longwood Collective members. For the M2 route (Harvard Medical School to Harvard Square) a Harvard ID or pre-purchased pass is required.



WHEN: Shuttles run Monday-Friday 5:05 a.m. to 12:30 a.m. except holidays. High-frequency service during rush hours, limited-service mid-days and nights. No weekend service except limited M2 Saturday service. Reduced M2 service in summer.



WHERE: 14 convenient stops through the LMA—most riders are just a 1-to-4 minute walk from their LMA workplace or school. See an interactive map at longwoodcollective.org/shuttles.

Emergency ride home: To encourage LMA employees to leave their car at home and use mass transit instead, the Longwood Collective offers a free “emergency ride home” service for any employee of a member institution that commutes via mass transit (including LMA Shuttles) and need to get home in the event of an emergency.
